

• The Board may choose to enter Executive Session for the purposes of discussing Security Matters and School Building Safety and Security, review of unreleased closed session meeting minutes, the setting of a price for sale or for lease of property owned by the public body, and the appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance, or dismissal of specific employees, specific individuals who serve as independent contractors in a park, recreational, or educational setting, or specific volunteers of the public body or legal counsel for the public body, including hearing testimony on a complaint lodged against an employee, a specific individual who serves as an independent contractor in a park, recreational, or educational setting, or a volunteer of the public body or against legal counsel for the public body to determine its validity.
